
For its tax incentives

In San Sebastian-Gipuzkoa, support for the audiovisual sector is not just lip service, but is accompanied by significant tax incentives. Foreign productions shooting in the region will benefit from a **35%** deduction in expenses in the Basque Country. The exemption of municipal taxes can be added to these incentives.



















